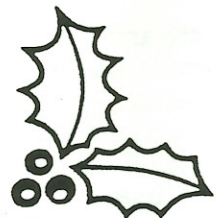

## MOREnet Selects Statewide Database

Ebsco MasterFILE 1000 has been selected to provide periodical indexing and full text articles to all MOREnet members for the 1996 calendar year. The Internet will be used to access the host computer in Massachusetts with either a vt100 emulation or windows client. MasterFILE 1000 is available to all MOREnet members, including public schools participating in the DESE Project, public libraries participating in the REAL Project, and community information network registered users. Funding for the database is provided by the State of Missouri.

MasterFILE 1000 provides cover to cover indexing and abstracting of 2,660 periodicals. Full text is available for 500 periodicals from January 1, 1990 and an additional 500 periodicals from January 1, 1994. The contract with Ebsco allows an unlimited number of simultaneous users and unlimited viewing, downloading, and printing. The search software and the database may be customized to meet the needs of the wide range of MOREnet users from primary school to higher education. The ascii database allows keyword searching of the full text, and information from charts, graphs, and photographs has been manually added to the text files. Sections of the text may be marked for printing or downloading. MasterFILE 1000 will be available in January.
