## ANNUAT MEETING NOTES

...Sara Parker addresses group
...new officers for Network
Sara Parker reported that nearly 700 people attended the "Charting Missouri Libraries Future" forums. St. Louis, one of eighteen cites, had over a hundred people in attendance. All types of libraries were represented with 75 - 100 school librarians in attendance at the eighteen cites. The discussion focus was what kinds of libraries and what. kinds of services did Missourians want in five years.

Based on preliminary reports the forums seemed to point to the following results. Most important was technology. Missouri libraries need a basic uniform level of technology available to all libraries. Libraries need access to information in all formats. An on-line statewide catalog is needed, as well as, Internet access. Leadership is needed from the state library for the technology projects. There needs to be a statewide coordination of goals and there is need for support and consulting services from the state. The state library and the other state agencies, DESE and the Higher Education Council, need to cooperate so the basic services are uniform within the state.

Training is needed for library staff and patrons, especially senior citizens. This training is needed close to home for the professional and paraprofessional staff.

Some other concerns voiced at the forums were children's programming, resource sharing, networking, ILI, and marketing to provide needed services.

What should be the responsibility of the state library and what should be the responsibility of the local library? How should funds from new federal program be allotted? Perhaps, the local library is responsible for the building, the staff and collections. The state library might be responsible for the infrastructure, care and maintenance of the union catalog and also to subsidize the automation costs. The state is working on a program which will be presented when completed. Federal funds might be used to finance the fixing of existing buildings so that they are handicap accessible and to fix the needed changes in buildings for new the technology.

The on-line catalog that will replace MCAT may be ready later this summer. More official information will be coming from the state as the forum results are tabulated.
