Plastic files:

The first set is a sky blue closed back file with a curved opening. These easily can be stored nested inside each other. They measure 11 1/2H x 4W x 8 3/4D. 94 files available.

The next type of file has an angled opening. These are similar to the Library Store, Inc. Plastic cut corner files found on page 85 of their Fall 96/ Winter 97 catalog or Brodarts Closed back files found on page 151 of their 1996 catalog. These files measure 11 1/2 H x 4 W x 8 3/4 D. We have 85 sky blue and 31 Orange files available.

We also have available open backed files. Their measurements are 12 1/4 H x 4 1/2 W x 9 1/2 D. We have 8 black, 3 sky blue, 5 orange, 4 green, and 1 yellow.

We will be taking bids for the above items till Tuesday 4/15/97. Make an offer for the entire lot or for individual items. We're interested in giving these items an extended shelf-life.

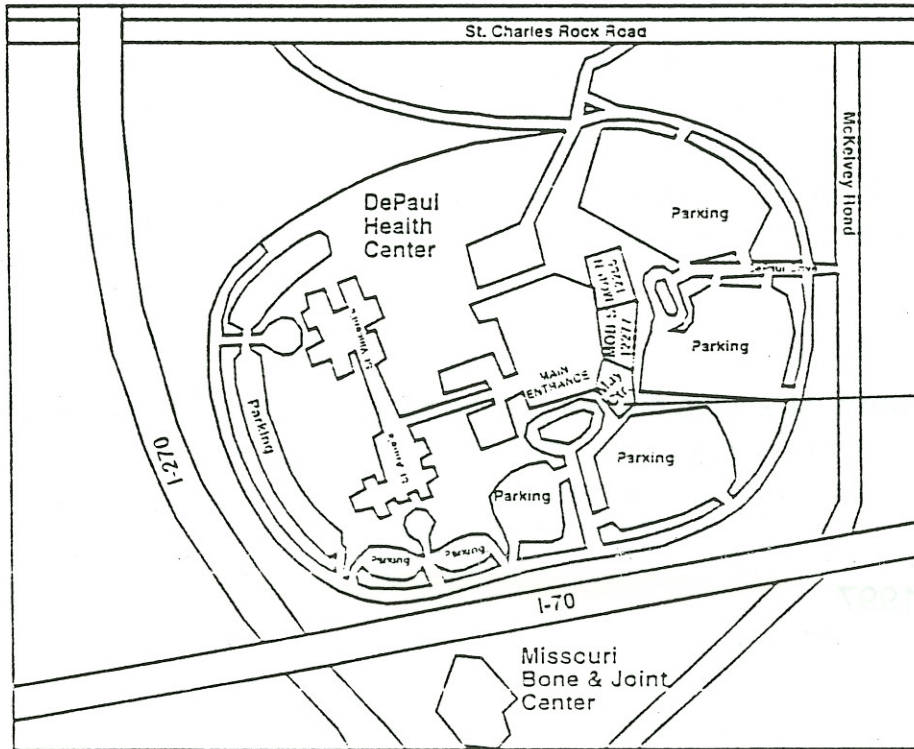
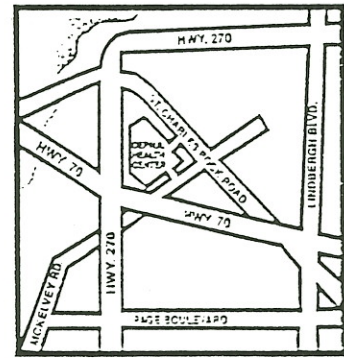

This workshop is useful for anyone involved
in repair of library materials and
participants will gain skills that can be
shared with other staff or volunteers.

This is a practical, hands-on seminar where
participants learn and practice basic repairs
for both hard and soft bound books. Emphasis
is placed on becoming familiar with
techniques and materials for economical in-
house repair of materials that must be
available for frequent use. Additionally,
protective measures which will extend the
life of new materials will be demonstrated
and discussed. Long-term preservation of
archival materials is not addressed.
