The Gateway to Educational Materials (GEM) at http://www.the gateway.org. is designed for teachers to type a topic, grade level, and other information into a search screen that retrieves -from more than 140 web sites- lessons, instructional units, and other free educational materials on that topic.

Another site that came from a call for federal agencies to improve and expand access to teaching and learning resources on the internet is http://www.ed.gov/free/. The Department of Education and more than 40 other federal organizations created this web site to make teaching and learning resources from across the federal government available in one place.

While teaching and learning resources are the aim of both GEM and FREE, FREE focuses only on those created with federal support. GEM includes mostly materials not created with federal support. Also the search tools differ. FREE searches full text of each resource and GEM relies on a card catalog system to match the search terms.
