

The St. Louis Regional Library Network now has a website: www.slrln.org

On the website you will find a list of membership benefits, list of members, INFO-PASS information and manual, Cooperative Purchasing manual. You will also be receiving your NETnews on the website. This will enable us to keep you up to date with current information (e.g. add additional authorized personal to your INFO-PASS signatures or add another vendor to the Cooperative Purchasing in the middle of the year).

The council decided to do this in an effort to save money on postage and supplies. The network no longer has a FAX number but you can contact us through the network phone 314-965-1305 or through the website email: info@slrln.org. Please bookmark this website and use it to update your library's information for INFO-PASS, or to contact us with other questions or suggestions.

Workshops will be advertised and registration forms will be on our website (starting July 1, 2004). When a workshop is scheduled or a NETnews is issued, a notice will be posted on the slrln list serve sponsored and maintained by Washington University. If you are not signed on to the list serve, I urge you to sign up. Very few messages come to you on this list serve so you will not be overwhelmed with email. Usually only one or two messages per month come over this list serve. There is no advertising, jokes, or spam. You can use it to publicize a program that is of interest to library community, list a job opening, give away library items or ask for library items (e.g. microfilm, microfiche, shelving, card catalog).
